This month's CHCA meeting will feature a presentation and community discussion about the latest developments for the proposed streetcar down Columbia Pike, linking Fairfax County and South Arlington to the Pentagon City Metro. A lot has changed since public discussions last year! **Stephen Del Giudice, Transit Bureau Chief for Arlington County**, will report the latest developments, which include upcoming preliminary engineering and environmental studies.

We also encourage you to support Columbia Heights Civic Association, which is working hard to represent the interests of our community. Our actions this past year includes:

- Securing \$350,000 in funding for a new fence behind the Walter Reed Community Center and stone entryways on 16th Street and Walter Reed, into the parking lots.
- Proposed project to upgrade street lighting to the new Carlisle Lighting for S. Barton St., S. 16th Street to S. Edgewood St., and S. Edgewood to 13th Rd.
- Updates to neighbors about new developments along Columbia Pike.
